

West Riding Coach Rambles: Housekeeping on the day

We want everyone to have a pleasant and smooth experience, so please take a moment to familiarize yourself with these guidelines before the day. If you have any special needs or require assistance, don't hesitate to reach out to a committee member—they're here to help. Let's make it a memorable outing for all.

- Please arrive promptly at the pic-up point. Being on time not only ensures a smooth start to the outing but also demonstrates respect for your fellow travellers and the schedule planned for the day, so that everyone can enjoy the day without unnecessary delays.
- Please leave the front 2 pairs of seats free for the committee.
- Please put your bags in the hold.
- Please bring spare footwear to change into after the walk, because we can't wear muddy boots on the coach. Many members like to bring a clean outfit to wear at the pub (not essential).
- You will need a card in most places to pay for dinner. It is a good idea to bring a small amount of cash if you wish to leave a tip for the pub staff and/ or our driver. This is voluntary. If the dinner venue only accepts one payment method, we will try to warn you in advance.
- The leaders or committee members may take photos on the day. We don't normally identify walkers in any publicity that goes into the West Riding Magazine or on the Website or social media, but if you don't want a photo of yourself to appear, please let the leader know at the start.

If you tell the leader first, we can ensure your preferences are respected, making the event enjoyable for all participants.

Remember to also pack enough water and packed lunch, including any snacks you might need to stay energised during the walk. While the group stops are planned, having your own provisions is essential, carried in your backpack.
